

Approach to Beverley - the Last 10 Miles

Significant landmarks are listed below with magnetic bearing to Beverley & distance in nautical miles in square brackets.

- 1. Driffield airfield (disused) [145 / 7]. Note large white hangars.
- 2. Lissett windfarm [210 / 7]
- 3. D-shaped & round reservoirs. The runway centre is on a bearing of approximately 155 degrees from the centre of the round one.
- 4. Hornsea Mere [270 / 6]
- 5. Beverley town (note cathedral 'Beverley Minster') [035 / 4]
- 6. Humber Bridge [020 / 12]
- 7. VOR Ottringham (OTR) [325 / 15]

The villages of Leven and Brandesburton are within the ATZ, to the east of the runway. Please avoid overflying these villages on arrival and departure. Right base for runway 30 should be flown to the west of the villages.
